### **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

This course trains students to express themselves by means of three types of unified and coherent paragraphs, descriptive, narrative, and expository paragraphs. They learn the principles of paragraph writing through modeling, inquiry, and discovery and practice writing paragraphs as class and home assignments. The students' achievement is assessed by means of their class attendance, activity, portfolio, mid-semester test, and semester exams.

# **INSTRUCTIONAL OBJECTIVES**

At the end of this course, the students are expected can distinguish and write narrative, descriptive, and expository paragraphs with adequate unity, coherence, and cohesion.

# **COURSE REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. Every student is required to attend all meeting
- 2. Every student is required to do the assigned tasks such as exercise, take quizzes, mid semester, and final semester examinations.
- 3. Every student is required to read the textbooks at least the assigned chapters or pages
- 4. Every student might be assigned to present a certain topic or given questions in class or small groups.
